President Josh Mensing vote- yes

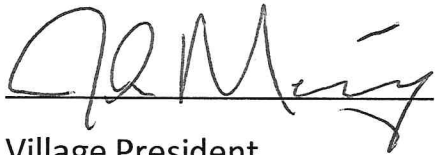
Public Comment:

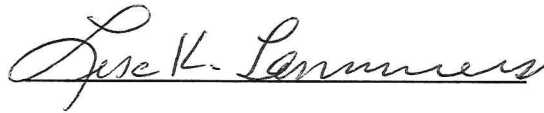
President Josh Mensing assured them that action would be taken and that violations would be handled.
