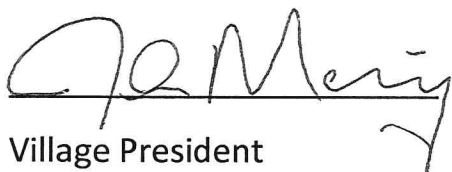
Public Comment:
